

2025 Mid-Year Gratitude Report



Thanks to you, the first half of 2025 has been a remarkable chapter for Second Helpings Atlanta. Your generosity helped us rescue and deliver **1,550,633** pounds of food — enough for **1,292,194** meals across metro Atlanta. Our Food Rescue Network continues to grow, fueled by the support of **30** new donors who joined us this year.

Through our Field to Fork program, we've distributed **325,724** pounds of fresh, Georgia grown produce so far this year — rescued directly from Georgia farms and redirected to families who need it most.

Your impact goes beyond hunger relief. By keeping good food out of landfills, you've helped prevent **1.53** metric tons of CO₂e emissions — which equates to 3.89 billion miles driven by an average gasoline powered passenger vehicle, protecting our planet while nourishing our community.

We're so grateful to have you with us on this journey. Thank you for making this impact possible — we can't wait to see what we'll accomplish together in the second half of the year!
