Thanks to you, the first half of 2025 has been a remarkable chapter for Second Helpings Atlanta. Your generosity helped us rescue and deliver **1,550,633** pounds of food — enough for **1,292,194** meals across metro Atlanta. Our Food Rescue Network continues to grown, fueled by the support of **30** new donors who joined us this year.

Through our Field to Fork program, we've distributed **325,724** pounds of fresh, Georgia grown produce so far this year — rescued directly from Georgia farms and redirected to families who need it most.

Your impact goes beyond hunger relief. By keeping good food out of landfills, you've helped prevent **1.53** metric tons of CO₂e emissions — which equates to 3.89 billion miles driven by an average gasoline powered passenger vehicle, protecting our planet while nourishing our community.


